The CGEF is a volunteer organization that was founded in Cedar Grove for the purpose of enhancing and enriching educational experiences for our residents. Here's some of what we've done thus far:

- Awarded \$7500 in scholarships to deserving CG High School graduates since the establishment of the CGEF annual scholarship program.
- Made a \$5500 donation to the CG Board of Education in 2007 to convert one classroom at the high school into a Smart Classroom, which includes the purchase and installation of the computer components, software, and an interactive white board for the classroom, and to fund the professional development training necessary for its use.
- Established an Adult Education Program in town.
- Honored five distinguished community members at our 2005 and 2006 Honoree Dinner Galas and, as a result, made donations totaling \$3750 to several organizations, including DARE, the Gifted & Talented program, CGARS, and the CGHS Music Program, in the name of our honorees.
- Donated \$1,500 electronic keyboard to High School Music Department
- Funded \$7,300 for replacement (in 2009) of the High School Stage Rigging, a system of ropes and pulleys that are used during shows and plays.
